(Kennesaw, Ga) - Today Cobb County Magistrate Judge and former Deputy Chief Assistant District Attorney Sonja N. Brown announces her campaign for the open Superior Court seat held by the retiring Honorable Robert Flournoy, III. The election will take place in 2022. Judge Brown, who has resided in Cobb County for nearly 25 years, brings the most legal experience in the Superior Court to the 2022 race.

Judge Brown also served in the DeKalb County Solicitor-General's Office as a Deputy Chief Assistant Solicitor-General, and worked as a Chief Senior Assistant District Attorney with the Office of the Fulton County District Attorney where she was assigned to the Crimes against Women and Children Unit (CAWAC).

A firm believer in giving back, Judge Brown serves her community through many different avenues. She currently serves on the Board of Directors of the Tommy Nobis Center (TBC). She also serves on the Board of Trustees of the North Georgia United Methodist Conference (NGUMC). An avid supporter of the Covenant House of Georgia, Judge Brown has participated in Covenant House's annual *Sleep Out: Executive Edition*, which raises awareness about youth homelessness.
